Juror

Susan Parke was executive director of the Museum of Northwest Art from 1990 until 2003. It was during her tenure that the former Valley Museum of Northwest Art left its original home on the second floor of the historic Gaches Mansion and moved, in 1995, to a completely refurbished state of the art museum facility on La Conner's First Street.

In 2003, Parke left the directorship to be curator of collections and exhibitions at the Museum of Northwest Art, a return to the hands-on dealing with art that brought her to the museum field in the first place. This is a position she holds to the present.

Parke's background includes ten years as the owner of two contemporary galleries in Illinois: Susan Parke Contemporary Graphics and the Susan Parke Gallery. She has worked in university museums and galleries at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and at Wright State University, in Dayton, Ohio.

Her undergraduate degree was in Psychology, from the University of Toronto. She has graduate training in studio art, art history and museum studies from Edgewater College, Wright State University, Parkland College and the University of Illinois.

Parke lives in Anacortes WA with her painter husband, Dederick Ward.

“Currents: Contemporary Directions in Northwest Art”

Eligibility

- Artist must be 16 years of age or older and resident of WA, OR, ID MT, AK or British Columbia.
- Entries must be original, entirely the work of the entrant, executed within the last three years, and without the supervision of an instructor.
- Entries must not be copied, derivatives, or based on other copyrighted or published paintings or photographs.

Conditions

- Entries will be juried from slides or printed images (no e-mailed images). Awards will be judged from the original works of art.
- Works in two- and three-dimensional form including photography and crafts are eligible. Sculpture may not exceed 60" x 24" x 24" Two dimensional work may not exceed 60" length x 40" width including frame.
- Unless artist installs, no work may exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- All two-dimensional works on paper must have glass or plexiglass. Work must be sturdily framed and ready to hang, including wire. Shipped paintings must use plexiglass. Hand delivered work may use glass.
- Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work, alter the work or the sales price, nor withdraw the work after it has been accepted.
- Art Port Townsend reserves the right to refuse any work which does not match the slide or printed image or meet the media, size or framing criteria.

Entries

- A maximum of three entries per artist may be submitted for jurying.
- For Sculpture, up to three slides or prints may be submitted per entry.
- Slides must be 35 mm, in a standard 2" x 2" mount. No glass slides or unusually thick mounts will be accepted. No tape or attached labels should be used.
- Printed images must be no larger than 8" x 10" or smaller than 4" x 6" and labeled the same as slides

Entry Fees

A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 is required for a

maximum of three entries, payable to Northwind Arts Alliance. Entry postmark deadline for images, entry form and fees is Friday, August 11, 2006.

Accepted Works

- Works may be hand delivered or shipped.
- Instructions will be mailed in the notification letter. There will be a \$10.00 charge for each shipping container.
- If your work is not accepted, slides will be returned in your SASE envelope. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling slides and artwork, the Port Townsend Arts Commission, Northwind Arts Alliance, or its representatives will not be responsible for damage or loss from any cause. If accepted, images will be retained for records.

Sales

Unless specified NFS, it is assumed that all work is for sale. Northwind Arts Alliance will charge 30% commission for each art work sold.

Photography

Art Port Townsend reserves the right to photograph entries and use photographs for the purposes of documentation, education, publicity, and to encourage interaction of the arts.

Liability

Every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition, and return of work, but neither Port Townsend Arts Commission nor Northwind Arts Alliance will assume responsibility for loss or damage incurred. Artists should carry their own insurance. Work should not be so fragile that shipment or public display is potentially harmful to the work or the viewer.
