Lisa Van Doren is a freelance arts consultant in Bellingham, Washington. She served as Curator of Art at the Whatcom Museum of History & Art from 2002-2005, affording her regular opportunities to engage with regional art and artists. Her work at the Whatcom Museum included curating and organizing a range of exhibitions, from solo artists to group shows with over 100 participants. She is the author of *Story Rugs, Tales of Freedom: The Work of Dale Gottlieb*, and has contributed to numerous other exhibition catalogues. She earned a Master of Arts in Art History & Criticism from State University of New York at Stony Brook.

Eligibility

- Artist must be 16 years of age or older and resident of WA, OR, ID MT, AK or British Columbia.
- Entries must be original, entirely the work of the entrant, executed within the last three years, and without the supervision of an instructor.
- Entries must not be copied, derivatives, or based on other copyrighted or published paintings or photographs.

Conditions

- Entries will be juried from slides or printed images (no e-mailed images). Awards will be judged from the original works of art. See our website for slide/print guidelines.
- Work in two—and three—dimensional form including photography is eligible. Sculpture may not exceed 60" x 24" x 24" Two dimensional work may not exceed 60" length x 44" width including frame.
- Unless artist installs, no work may exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- All two-dimensional works on paper must have glass or plexiglass. Work must be sturdily framed and ready to hang, including wire. Shipped paintings must use plexiglass. Hand delivered work may use glass.
- Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work, alter the work or the sales price, nor withdraw the work after it has been accepted.
- Art Port Townsend reserves the right to refuse any work which does not match the slide or meet the media, size or framing criteria.

Slide Entries

- A maximum of three entries per artist may be submitted for jurying.
- For sculpture, up to three slides may be submitted per entry.
- Slides must be 35 mm, in a standard 2" x 2" mount. No glass slides or unusually thick mounts will be accepted. No tape or attached labels should be used.

Entry Fees

A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 is required for a maximum of three entries, payable to Northwind Arts Alliance. Entry postmark deadline for slides, entry form and fees is Saturday, August 10, 2007.

Accepted Works

- Works can be hand delivered or shipped. Instructions will be mailed in the notification letter. There will be a \$10.00 charge for each shipping container.
- If your work is not accepted, slides will be returned in your SASE envelope. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling slides and artwork, the Port Townsend Arts Commission, Northwind Arts Alliance, Northwind Arts Center or its representatives will not be responsible for damage or loss from any cause. If accepted, slides will be retained for records.

Sales

Unless specified NFS, it is assumed that all work is for sale. Northwind Arts Center will charge a 30% donation for each art work sold.

Photography

Art Port Townsend reserves the right to photograph entries for the purposes of documentation, education, publicity, and to encourage interaction of the arts.

Liability

Your work will be insured while at the Northwind Arts Center. However, work should not be so fragile that shipment or public display is potentially harmful to the work or the viewer.

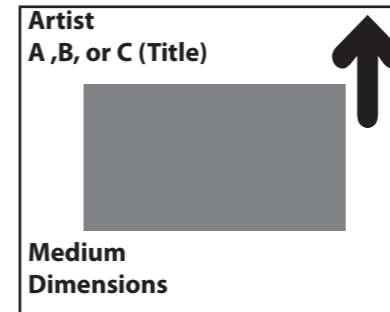
